#### 1) Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: Annual General PAC Meeting (November, 2022)

- 2) School Update: Principal Kevin Ward

- Grade 4s and 6s went to outdoor school and had a great time
- Kammi and Kevin went up to visit
- Hip Hop performance with Jessica Heaven went very well; note the PAC sponsored the dance lessons in the school.

- Kids had 3 dance workshops with Jessica, hoping to have more next year

- Longhouse trip will happen in May for the grade 3 students
- We've had to split them into 2 groups because the grade 3s are such a large group
- Track and field is starting after spring break
- Swangard is currently closed for the 2023 track and field season so there will not be a large meet there this year
- The method of grading of students will be changing come September 2023
- There will be information on the new Proficiency Scale being sent to parents after spring break

#### 3) PAC Chair Update: Kendra Low & Vanessa Mitchell

- Kulvir Mann has joined us tonight
- Kulvir is a school district trustee and former parent of canyon heights students
- She is a great advocate for safety in our area and around all schools
- Traffic issues around Canyon Heights have been exasperated
- We are looking at Canyon Heights being the pilot school for the Walking School Bus initiative
- Canyon Heights applied for a sustainability grant for \$4000 to encourage active transportation, we were successful in this application! Thank you to the District of North Van!
- March 30<sup>th</sup> is our Special Community Safety meeting please attend and tell your friends to attend.
- Neighbours within a 2-3 block radius of the school will be invited to the meeting to express any concerns they may have about parking and safety issues
- We will have a number of guests at the meeting: North Vancouver RCMP, District of North Vancouver staff and councillors, North Shore Safety Council, ICBC – Road Safety, North Vancouver School District – Sustainability & Facilities, North Vancouver School Board Trustees, Canyon Heights Elementary School Administration

- We are expecting a large turnout at the Community Safety meeting
- We have many concerned parents and neighbours about the safety and parking issues around our school
