• School Update: Principal Kevin Ward

- Expecting a larger intake of students next year, around 360 students
- Currently expecting around 39 kindergarten students
- Strong potential for a 16th division in 2024/25 school year
- Professional development days coming up staff will be exploring new online resources
- Track and field commencing April 22 expecting sign up to start soon; Swangard date set for June 4
- Gauging student interest for ultimate frisbee

Hot Lunch

Recycling Program

- No bottle drive this year
- We have Return It containers coming to the school for juice box returns etc. and
- Working on ongoing recycling fundraising.

PAC Spending/Budget

- See Power point slide with listing of PAC spend expected.
- Note the PAC had originally budgeted for a dance group to teach each class but that fell through. Instead, the PAC is providing funds for an intermediate bike class (Hop On) that will be run in June. No concerns raised.
- PAC has been advised that we have now been approved for our gaming grant for this school year and we expect approximately \$6,000 of gaming money to be deposited soon. There is much compliance and some reporting around the gaming money. Treasurer discussed specifics of the gaming grant.
- Discussion on the process for setting the budget, and adjustments as necessary, on an annual basis. It was noted the spend priorities are set in collaboration with teachers and administrators.
- 2023/24 was technology focused. This year we have allocated to a number of workshops/programs, the library and other important areas of the school (see PPT slide with specific amounts per item). We are also looking at basketball hoops as part of the outdoor refresh.
